Ordinance Forbidding the Placement of Snow or Ice on Town Highways

Pursuant to the authority conferred by New Hampshire Revised Statues Annotated, Chapter 41, Section 11, in order to promote the general welfare and safety of the residents of the Town of Sharon and the traveling public, the following Ordinance is hereby enacted:

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to put or place or cause to be put or placed any snow or ice upon the surface of the traveled portion of any class V highway for any purposes, except to provide a place necessary for crossing, recrossing and traveling upon said highway by sleds, logging or logging equipment.

Whoever shall fail to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50) Dollars and not more than Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars, and may be required to reimburse the Town for expenses incurred to remove any such snow or ice.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by the Board of Selectmen, publication in the Monadnock Ledger-Transcript, and upon the recording of an attested copy of the Ordinance with the Town Clerk.
