Trail Work

Anne F. and Ken Callahan plan to work on Matthews trail on Friday August 29. All are invited.

Beavers

Anne Booth contacted Mike Callahan's company, Beaver Solutions LLC, which John Evans is now running. He told her that in order to get the beaver device serviced, we needed to re-up the agreement (for a fee). We signed the initial contract in December of 2023, and should have had service included in the following 12-month period, yet they claim that it is within a calendar year and not a 12-month period. The device needed to be cleaned in 2024, and Anne had sent Mike photos of the debris accumulating. Now

the debris has created a dam, causing the fencing on the device to bend, allowing water to flow over. Anne B. is going to call John back and explain that that would have given us one month of service, that they knew of our need for service within a 12-month period and now the device is not functioning properly.

Swearing in

Megan was sworn in as a full member of the Conservation Commission.
